## **CHARGE TO THE CHGD EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE**

The Executive Committee serves as the body that approves policy, developed together with the Director, for the organization and operation of the Center, including matters dealing with Center budget, staffing, assignment of duties, and recommendations for promotion.

The Executive Committee consists of at least five (5), but not more than six (6) Center members, plus the Director, who serves as ex officio. Five members are nominated by vote of the Center membership. One additional member may be nominated by the Director to further broaden the representation of CHGD programmatic themes. These individuals are recommended and approved by the Vice President for Research. Executive Committee members are selected for two-year, staggered terms.

Meetings of the Executive Committee are scheduled at least once a month during the academic year. The agenda for such meetings is set by the Director with recommendations from the Executive Committee and Center Members. Individuals desiring to address the Executive Committee may do so by advising the Director no later than the close of the working day preceding the scheduled meeting.

A quorum for voting shall consist of at least three members of the Executive Committee. The Director convenes and chairs the Executive Committee and votes only in case of ties. The Director is authorized to call the Executive Committee into closed session when indicated by circumstances involving the welfare and privacy of individuals.

The Executive Committee, upon the recommendation of the Director, shall appoint such standing and ad hoc committees as it deems necessary to provide advice and guidance on policy matters relating to Center operations. Creation of all committees will be accompanied by written charges of specific responsibilities. Standing committees have one-year, renewable terms of service.
